

## THIRD CONDITIONAL

#### **REMEMBER!!**

Conditional sentences have two parts: an 'if clause' and a 'result' clause.

The **'if clause'** is the part that describes the hypothetical situation that we want to speak about - "If I had found your wallet, ..."

The **'result clause'** is the part that explains what results may come from the hypothetical 'if clause' actually happening - "..., I would have given it back to you."

### <u>3RD CONDITIONAL - IMPOSSIBLE</u> <u>BECAUSE IT'S IN THE PAST</u>

The Third Conditional is used to hypothesize about situations that that have already happened, and therefore have a zero percent chance of becoming true.

We use this particulare conditional a lot when we want to complain about or criticize something from the past.

It can also be use to give advice after something has happened, to help us learn how to deal with similar situations differently in the future.



#### STRUCTURE & EXAMPLES

**Structure:** If + Past Perfect, Subject + would/could/might + Present Perfect Remember, we can change the order and put the result clause first. The only difference is that the comma is no longer needed. We use 'would' when we feel certain about the result, 'could' when we think it's a possible result, and 'might' when we think it's a probable result

- If I had had more time, I would have studied Japanese. (certain)
- If they <u>had been</u> here, they <u>could have helped</u> us move the furniture. (possible)
- She <u>might have been</u> angry too if she <u>had known</u> what happened. (probable)
- What would you have done if you had won the lottery? (general for questions)
- It <u>wouldn't have happened</u> if I <u>had been</u> more careful (negative)
- If you hadn't been there, they would have got lost (negative)
