A good cause: a good reason, something worth doing.

To donate / To make a donation: To give something to someone / an organisation for free.

To dig deep: to make a big effort

To beg: desperately ask for help/money

To raise money: collect money from many people (usually for a good cause)

A fundraiser: an event whose goal is to raise money for a good cause.
