- To declare war (on) - When on country/state officially starts a war with another country/state
- To go to war - when two countries enage in a war
- To launch an attack - to start an attack against someone / something
- To launch an invasion - to officially start invading a country / state
- To invade - to officially start invading a country / state

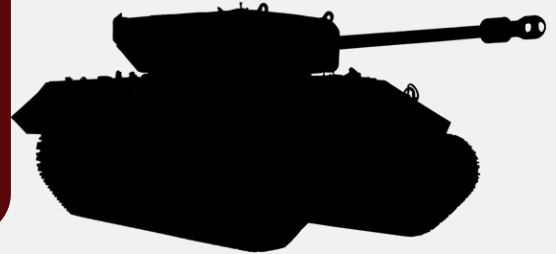


MORE VOCABULARY

- Military Forces**- the armed organisation of a country whose primary responsibility is to engage in warfare.
- Armed Forces** - another name for the Military forces
- Soldiers** - The people who are members of the military forces
- Troops** - Another word for soldier
- Civilian** - any person who is not a member of the armed forces.
- Wounded** - any person, military or civilian who is hurt during a war
- Dead** - any person, military or civilian who is killed during a war
- Advance** - when military forces are able to move forward
- Retreat** - when military forces are obliged to 'move backwards
