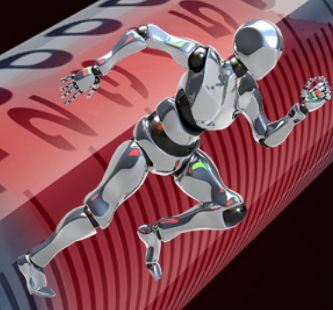

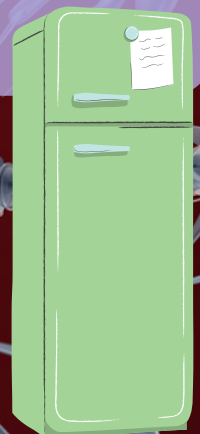


ZOOM IN...
