THE FOY OF TRAVEL

Vocabulary:

<u>To Travel</u> - go from one place to another, typically over quite a distance.

<u>A journey</u> - the noun to describe the experience of travelling from one place to another.

<u>A voyage</u> - a long journey involving travel by sea (or space!)

<u>A trip</u> - a (short) journey or excursion, especially for pleasure.

"I travel a lot for work"

"The journey from Milan to Rome takes 4 hours"

"The Voyage to South America took 4 weeks"

"Last Saturday, we had a lovely trip to the mountains"





Vocabulary:

Baggage/Luggage (uncount noun) - the whole of your bags and suitcases.
Suitcase (Count noun) - a 'bag' specially designed for travelling.
Trolley (count noun) - A 'suitcase' with wheels

<u>To pack/unpack your bags/suitcase</u> - put your clothes etc. into/take your clothes etc. out of your suitcase/trolley in preparation for your journey.

<u>To go sightseeing</u> - to explore a specific place visiting its main attractions.
