



Asking for directions

You can use any of these:

 Excuse me, could you help me find [place/landmark]?

- Hi there, I'm a bit lost. Can you tell me how to get to [location]?
- Hey, sorry to bother you, but do you know the way to [place]?
- Pardon me, I'm looking for (destination).
 Can you point me in the right direction?
- Hi, I wonder if you could lend me a hand.
 I need to reach (location). Any idea how to get there?
- Sorry for interrupting, but I'm a bit lost.
 Do you happen to know how to get to [place]?



Giving Directions Vocabulary

- Go straight ahead ⇒: Continue in the same direction without turning.
- Turn left/right: Change your direction to the left/right side.
- Take the first/second road on the left/right: Choose the left/right road at the indicated junction.
- Cross the street/road : Walk from one side of the street/road to the other.
- Keep walking until you reach...
 Continue walking until you arrive at the mentioned destination.
- · It's just around the corner: The destination is close by
- You can't miss it : The landmark or destination is easily visible and noticeable.
- Go back the way you came : Return in the direction you were previously walking.
- Take a detour To go on a different route than originally planned.
- It's on your left/right-hand side: The destination is situated to the left/right side



Confirming Understanding

Clarifying

Vocabulary You Will Need

- You got it! So, you'll just need to go straight ahead for about two blocks, and then take a left at the traffic lights.
- Yup, that's right! So, you'll walk down this street,
 cross the bridge, and then turn right when you
 spot the post office.
- Yes, that's the way! Just keep going straight, and in a few minutes, you'll arrive at the central square.
- Sure thing! The XXX you're looking for is the tall clock tower on your left. Can't miss it!
- No need to go back to the intersection. Just keep going straight, and you'll find the museum on your left-hand side.
- Not really... After the museum, you should walk past the park, and then you'll see a small café on your right-hand side.


