
Writing Strategies THE SWOOSH NARRATIVE

The swoosh narrative is a basic formula that can be used for writing a short story under timed conditions. It only has four main plot sections and two or three characters. It has a single time frame, place or location and action or situation. The protagonist must grow or change because of some catalyst. It doesn't need a clear resolution but one should be implied.



INCITING INCIDENT

Start in media res, in the middle of action, to grip your reader's attention and engage them through an exciting hook. Use emotive language and verbs to create action.

BACKFILL

With careful signposting to flash back, provide the back story as to how the characters arrived in this situation they are in.

RISING ACTION

Build tension and suspense while you return to the present and progress the plot towards the climax.

CLIMACTIC RESOLUTION

Finish at a high point of tension, but one where the reader can imagine how the rest of the story plays out.
